Work on making something together to remind you Jesus is with you. This can be a tag for a stuffed animal, a paper person, a magnet for a refrigerator, or whatever your family will see and be reminded of Immanuel.

Pray and thank Jesus for being with us and ask that we always recognize that he is with us.
