We have talked about Jesus as the Alpha and Omega (beginning and end), Immanuel (God with us), the Good Shepherd, and The Way. We also know Jesus is the Prince of Peace. What is peace? Why is it important that Jesus is in charge of (prince) peace?

Read Isaiah 9:6. Talk about each of the titles given to the coming Messiah. Talk about how Jesus fulfilled each of them, especially “Prince of Peace.”

Talk about one story in which Jesus brought peace. Draw a picture of that story together.

Fill a cup or bowl with water. Toss some marbles or pebbles into the water. Talk about how the water is disturbed when the marble hits the water, but the water eventually rests and becomes peaceful again. In the same way, Jesus brings peace to the chaos of the world.

When are some good times to ask Jesus for peace? (scared, nervous, sad, angry, etc.)

Talk about animals and ask which ones are peaceful and why. (e.g. Is a shark peaceful? No, because it hunts and invokes fear. Is a cow peaceful? Yes, because it is calm and still and doesn't have a care in the world.)

Pray and ask Jesus to give us peace even in the craziest times.
